The Marion County Domestic Violence Council was established in 1990 and consists of community members and public agencies committed to ending domestic violence. One of the council members is the Mid-Valley Women's Crisis Service, which provides support and advocacy for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, including a support hotline, emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence, counseling, and community education and outreach.



Last year we held the fourth annual Domestic Violence Awareness Walk/Run to raise awareness of domestic violence. The event raised more than \$4000 and 50% of the net proceeds went directly to the Mid-Valley Women's Crisis Service. The other 50% is used for ongoing domestic violence awareness efforts in our community. The success of this event was due in great part to our many local community sponsors. Lately with the current financial times we have found that many of our participating agencies are not able to contribute as much as they were able to the past three years, making your financial support much more vital.
